macadam parks and farmland as he traces this uniquely american story from the pilgrims to the smart city kriegler delivers a striking new history of our built environment the puritans were the first utopians seeking a new jerusalem in the new england villages that still stand as models of small town life in the age of revolution thomas jefferson dreamed of citizen farmers tending plots laid out across the continent in a grid of enlightened rationality as industrialization brought urbanization reformers answered emerging slums with a zealous crusade of grand civic architecture and designed the vast urban parks vital to so many cities today the twentieth century brought cycles of suburban dreaming and urban renewal one generation s utopia forming the next one s nightmare and experiments as diverse as walt disney s epcot hippie communes and las vegas kriegler s compelling and richly illustrated narrative reminds us as we formulate new ideals today that we chase our visions surrounded by the glories and failures of dreams gone by
